“ I met Earl Paysinger, back in April 1982, I remember meeting him and the fear I felt when I did. I had heard about Earl's reputation, well known by many as a strong and disciplined man. When he spoke, you listened. I was a brand new recruit in the police academy and Earl was my PT instructor and later became my training officer in Southwest Division.

Earl and I worked a black and white together, 3A55. I remember Earl because of his great fashion statement. He always wore a long sleeve shirt, even in the hot summer. His shoes were always spit shined and his tie bar was always straight. I don't know how he managed that but you never saw his uniform out of place! Even Earl's handwriting was phenomenal not to mention he had an incredible memory. Earl was the perfect example of command presence and car integrity. I remember a time that he and I heard a radio broadcast of a 211/GTA that just occurred. Minutes later Earl and I were following the 211/GTA vehicle with 4 juveniles inside. The subjects quickly pulled over and stopped without us activating our lights. We had requested backup at which time Earl grabbed the "PA" and in his God fearing voice said, "You boys are in BIG Trouble! Do not move, and don't think about running!" The subjects didn't move and you could see the fear in their faces. Upon a search of the vehicle a loaded pistol was recovered, and it ended well without any issues. Earl had that voice that was quite intimidating and that day was proof for me.

I will remember Earl as Foley from An Officer and a Gentleman. A strong and fearless leader, yet humble and dedicated to his work. Sir, you are the example of a true command presence, hard worker and outstanding, First Assistant Chief with a voice heard by many and respected. Your hard edge and kind heart touched many of our lives and you will truly be missed!! It was a pleasure meeting and working with you Earl Paysinger, Rest in Peace.
