Guadalupe (Lupe) Ramirez, of Carson, CA, passed away on May 9, 2020, at the age of 82. He was born in Morenci, Arizona to Emeterio Ramirez and Paula Bustamante, one of eight children. He spent his childhood years in Phoenix, Arizona and in Merced, California. When he was 17, he met the love of his life, Julia Carrillo.
