Margaret Mary Hynes Born February 24, 1926 in San Francisco, California to Louis Joseph Vasquez and Teresa Valdes Vasquez, passed away on May 28, 2019 in her home in Rancho Palos Verdes, California.

Margaret, known throughout her life as Peggy, grew up in San Francisco during the depression - when times were tough and people were willing to help one another. She came of age during the Second World War, seeing her brothers go off to fight in Europe and her mother go to work in the shipyards as a real Rosie the Riveter, welding iron nets. Peggy would work hard all her life--she had 22 jobs before marrying Bill Hynes; from sewing underage in a factory, to the post office, to being a ticket taker at the San Francisco Opera House, to being a teacher and recreation director. She got her Bachelor's degree and teaching credential at California State University of San Francisco. Peggy was also an athlete swimming competitively, enjoying tennis, horseback riding and golf. She loved theatre and the arts and modern dance as a college student.

Peggy was always an active person, be it gardening or involved in church, school activities, or sports and deeply enjoying where she lived in beautiful southern California. She had a passion for sewing, knitting and crocheting. Peggy and Bill were known for throwing great parties and family dinners, regularly cooking up a feast for the masses.

Faith was a very important to Peggy and after raising 7 children she was often a volunteer at St. John Fisher. For years she volunteered to make hundreds of sandwiches for the hungry and homeless, and would often crochet or knit blankets or booties for new mothers.

She was preceded in death by her parents, brothers, her first born daughter Teresa and her beloved husband of 54 years, William Thomas Hynes Jr. Together they raised seven children. Her surviving children: Margie, Ed, Ellie, Katie, Sue and Mary Ellen, will celebrate her life at Green Hills Mortuary Monday, June 10, at 11:30am. 2019.
